- I certify that my boat complies with all applicable Australian Sailing and class safety regulations, including Australian Sailing Special Regulations, Part 2 for Off the Beach boats. I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that my boat continues to meet safety regulations at all times.
- I acknowledge that I am required to wear a personal flotation device (PDF) which complies with Australian standards and that inflatable PFD's shall not be used.
- I agree to be bound by the rules of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) of World Sailing, and the Prescriptions of Australian Sailing, and the Constitution, By-Laws and Sailing Instructions of CPSC and Class Rules.
- I agree to pay any applicable CPSC Race Entry fees
- I understand that CPSC reserves the right to refuse any entry.

**Disclaimer of liability & risk warning**

This Risk Warning is issued jointly by CPSC and NSW Roads & Maritime, pursuant to the Civil Liability Act 2002 to all persons wishing to participate in this event.

Competitors take part in CPSC races at my own risk and responsibility and that my decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is mine alone. (See RRS 4, Decision to Race.)

The Organising Authority, CPSC, NSW Roads & Maritime, their directors, officers, volunteers and sponsors:

- a) will not accept any liability for damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after this event; and
- b) shall not be responsible for the seaworthiness of any boat whose entry is accepted, the adequacy of its equipment or its insurance arrangements.

c) Participants are warned that, regardless of the precautions which might be taken by reasonable and experienced persons, sailing can be a dangerous pursuit and participants are exposed to significant risk of property damage, physical harm and possibly death. These risks may include, but are not limited to:

- the extremes of weather and sea conditions;
- the potential that control of vessels may be lost, resulting in collisions;
- the sudden movement of the vessel at any time and the possibility that participants may fall or be thrown overboard;
- the possibility that participants may be injured by equipment on the vessel;
- the absence of immediate medical care and the likelihood that significant delays may occur before medical care is available;
- exposure to the elements for extended periods.

d) The Organising Authority, CPSC, the Association and NSW Roads & Maritime jointly warn participants that regardless of their best intentions, they may be unable to render assistance to participants who are in distress.

e) Participants are warned to consider all risks before deciding to participate in any sailing event.

CPSC strongly recommends that each participating boat be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per event or the equivalent.
